

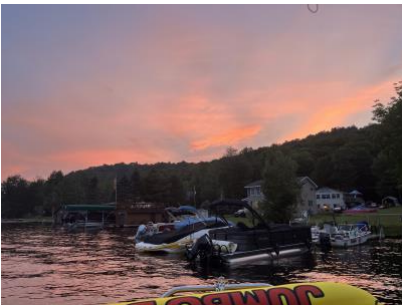

Requiring all boats and PWC that utilize the boat launch to be registered with the HHPOA with a “dock” or “launch only” sticker clearly displayed is new for 2024. This is a result of the large number of complaints made to the Board about non-members utilizing the boat launch.
